



## ***Loose Change for LIFE***

### **What is Loose Change for Life?**

The Loose Change for Life Campaign is an easy way for everyone in your congregation to help protect the unborn through the life-saving work of the Cleveland Pregnancy Center (CPC).

### **How does the campaign work?**

The campaign is announced to the congregation through a bulletin blurb, pastor announcement, and/or guest speaker from the Cleveland Pregnancy Center. Baby bottles are available after the service for all those who would like to participate in the Loose Change for Life Campaign. Interested individuals take home a baby bottle, fill it with loose change (or paper money or check) and return it to church on the designated date. The bottles are then returned to the CPC. We count the money for you, and then we will notify you of the total amount your church raised to help save the lives of the yet-to-be born.

### **Who provides the bottles?**

The Cleveland Pregnancy Center provides the bottles, along with a tag on each one to remind participants of the return date. If your church would like to purchase your bottles, that would be a huge blessing! With the Cleveland Pregnancy Center's significant bulk discount, each bottle costs just \$.99.

### **When should we hold the Loose Change for Life Campaign?**

***You may choose any time of the year that works for your church.*** Many churches find it particularly meaningful to hold their campaigns during Sanctity of Human Life Month (January), Mother's Day – Father's Day, or Respect Life Month (October).
