

Elder Leave of Absence Policy

Adopted at CVC Elder's Meeting, 11/21/2002

Any elder needing a break in active service may take a leave of absence. The break should be no less than 6 months and no more than 12 months. Additional time may be granted upon review by the elders. During the leave, the elder has no voting privileges in the matters put before the elders. Upon returning to active service, the elder must attend one elder meeting before being eligible to vote. An elder is not limited to the number of "LOA" he can take. An elder may not return for a "crucial vote" only to take an additional LOA after the "crucial vote" has been taken.
