Do any other passages of Scripture come to mind as you interact with this topic? If so, share one and how you see it connect to this topic.

Why has Christmas become more about "getting" than "giving" (especially for our kids), and how can we make efforts to reverse that emphasis?

How can our tradition of gift-giving at Christmas reflect in some way the incarnation, the power, and the beauty of God coming into our world as one of us and being "God with us"?

What excites you about giving intentional, meaningful, and relational gifts at Christmas? What will be your biggest challenge in doing so? How can you endeavor to overcome that challenge?

What is something you can remove or change?
