## VOYAGE 08.28.2016

### [set up]

In Acts 8:26-40, what are the components of personal evangelism in this story? How much arguing and persuading does Philip have to do?

### [digging deeper]

**Read Acts 1:8** – Jesus spoke these words from Jerusalem – home to the people he was talking to. Then he moves out in concentric circles. Jerusalem (home/local), in all Judea and Samaria (domestic), uttermost parts of the world (international). These are not suggestions – Jesus says you WILL BE my witnesses in these places. Do you believe that everyone has the Biblical command to share both locally and globally? Why or why not?

Can you support your position with Scripture?

**Read Matthew 24:3-14** – In what ways does this verse teach us about the importance of taking the gospel to the unreached in the world?

### [living it out]

1. Who is one person that you will commit to pray for and actively look for opportunities to turn the conversation towards Christ?
2. How can your family/LifeGroup be more intentional about loving our neighborhood? Make a plan and put it into action.
3. How might your group help with CVC church plants around the city - in addition to prayer?
4. How many in your group are discipling others in a smaller group? What can you cut in your schedule to make that happen?
5. What is your plan for being on mission to the SOLI? Make a plan with your family, spouse, work so that within the next 3-5 years you can take time to be on mission to the unreached.
