RIGHT WITH GOD 10.11.2015

[set up]

As we look through the book of Romans, there are a lot of things that can be difficult to swallow. As we consider the end of this study through Romans, talk in your group about how this series has impacted you and how you sense the Lord calling you to respond to the truths that we have learned.

[digging deeper]

As you consider the second point of this week's sermon - Be Obedient - look back through Romans and write out a list of the ways in which Romans calls us to obedience.

Talk with your group about the list and the areas in which the Holy Spirit is calling you to obedience.

Read Romans 1:18-20. Does anyone have any excuse for their sinfulness?

Read Romans 3:23. If we have no excuse, then we are guilty. What is the penalty of sin? What is the only way to escape that penalty?

Read Romans 10:1-17. What do these verses tell us about how people come to faith in Jesus?

What are the implications of these truths for the 3 billion people in the world who have never heard the good news?

[living it out]

What is our response to be? What is YOUR response going to be? What are you, your family, and your group going to do about the 3 billion people who have not yet heard of Jesus?
