

LESSON OVERVIEW

Know what your child is learning, and synch it up at home.

WEEK 1

1 Samuel 16:1-50

God helps David defeat a giant named Goliath.

Key Question: Who helps you do big things?

Bottom Line: God helps me do big things.

WEEK 2

1 Samuel 20:14-17; 2 Samuel 9:1-13

David becomes king and is kind to Mephibosheth.

Key Question: Who helps you do big things?

Bottom Line: God helps me do big things.

WEEK 3

1 Kings 5:1—6:38; 8:12-21

God helps King Solomon build the temple.

Key Question: Who can do what God says?

Bottom Line: I can do what God says.

WEEK 4

1 Kings 17:1-6

God sends ravens to feed Elijah.

Key Question: Who will take care of you?

Bottom Line: God will take care of me.

WEEK 5

1 Kings 18:1-39

God answers Elijah's prayers with fire from heaven.

Key Question: Who can believe in the one, true God?

Bottom Line: I can believe in the one, true God.

SIMPLE WAYS TO BRING THE LESSONS HOME...



MORNING TIME

When you see your child first thing in the morning say, “Good morning, my wonderful son/daughter! Today, you will need so many things. You will need food. You will need water. You will need air to breathe. You will need clothes to wear and a house to live in. Who will take care of you and give you all these things? God will take care of you! He will give you everything you need!”



PLAY TIME

How did your child learn to walk? Practice. How did your child learn to eat with a spoon? Practice. We practice everything else with our children, why not practice obeying? Tell him/her obeying parents is something God wants us to do, so it’s time to practice. Tell your child to stand at one end of the hallway while you’re at the other end. Say, “Come to mommy/daddy.” When he/she comes toward you, reward him/her with a big hug and a high five. Continue with other simple commands for about 15 minutes. Include some playful things. When you are finished, tell your child he is doing what God says just like King Solomon when Solomon built the temple.



DRIVE TIME

As you are about to drive off say, “Since God helps us help others, let’s look for ways we can help others while we’re at the _____. We can think of ways to help on our way. Let’s see, at the _____, someone may need us to smile and let them go first or let them have a closer parking spot. What are other ways we can help at the _____?”



BATH TIME

Find five medium-sized rocks, clean them up, and have them ready for bath time. Once your child is in the tub, tell him/her to close his/her eyes while you put the rocks in the water with him/her. His job is to find the rocks! Want to make it even harder? Add bubble bath when you run the bath water. Your child will have to feel around for the rocks to find them. Talk about how God helped David do a big thing and defeat huge Goliath with just five rocks and a sling. God will help your child do big things, too!



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child and pray, “Dear Father God, We believe in You, the one, true God. There is no one like You. You are amazing and perfect and good. We believe in You, praise You, follow You, and love You. In Jesus’ name we pray. Amen.”
