

LESSON OVERVIEW

Know what your child will learn at church, and synch it up at home.

WEEK 1

Exodus 1:22—2:10

God helps Miriam and her mother protect baby Moses from Pharaoh.

Key Question: Who takes care of you?

Bottom Line: God takes care of me.

WEEK 2

Exodus 3:1—4:17

God sees that His people are suffering in Egypt, so God speaks to Moses through a burning bush, revealing what He is like and what He wants Moses to do.

Key Question: Who sees, cares, and has a plan?

Bottom Line: God sees, cares, and has a plan.

WEEK 3

Exodus 13:21-22; Numbers 14:14

God frees His people from slavery and leads them through the wilderness in a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night.

Key Question: Who is always with His people?

Bottom Line: God is always with His people.

WEEK 4

Exodus 12:30-42, 12:50-51, 13:1—14:31

God shows His might when He fights for His people, parting the Red Sea so they can escape Pharaoh's army.

Key Question: Who is mighty?

Bottom Line: God is mighty.

WEEK 5

Exodus 16:1—17:7

The Israelites need food and water in the wilderness. God provides manna, quail, and water.

Key Question: Who takes care of you?

Bottom Line: God takes care of me.

SIMPLE WAYS TO BRING THE LESSONS HOME...



MORNING TIME

Wake your child this morning and say, “Good morning! I love you. I can’t wait to see what great and wonderful things God will do today! Let’s pray and watch, and He will show us what He is like and what He wants us to do. How exciting!”



PLAY TIME

Go outside and see just how mighty you and your preschooler are! How fast can you run? How many push-ups can you do? How high can you jump? How long can you hang from the bar on the swing set? How high can you swing? Do you have enough might to climb a tree? Whew! The options for testing your might are endless, but there is an end to your might. There is not an end to God’s might, though! Tell your child that God is mightier than anything we could ever imagine! God is ALMIGHTY!



DRIVE TIME

We want your child to always remember that God is with him/her wherever he/she goes. Getting in the car is the perfect time to teach this truth. Each time you get in the car tell your child, “We’re going to [name of place]. God is with us at [name of place] because God is always with His people wherever they go.” Keep doing this all month long, and before you know it, your child will truly believe that God is with him/her wherever he/she goes.



BATH TIME

As your child plays in the bath water, talk about how Moses and the Israelites couldn’t go anywhere because the water in front of them was so big! But then God did something only He can do. He made a way for them by parting the water and forming a dry path where they could walk. Ask your child to try and part the water in the tub by pushing it to the sides with his/her hands. It won’t work because only our mighty God can do that!



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child and pray. “Dear Father God, Thank You for taking care of baby Moses. Thank You for taking care of all the Israelites. And thank You for taking care of [child’s name]. You are a good God, strong and mighty, showing us who You are, going with us wherever we go, and caring for us with love. We thank You. We praise You. We love You. In Jesus’ name we pray. Amen.”
