
November 2021 PRESCHOOL



LESSON OVERVIEW

Know what your child will learn at church, and synch it up at home.

MEMORY VERSE

"Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid...for the Lord your God goes with you."

Deuteronomy 31:6, NIV

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WEEK 1

Daniel 3 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego trust the one, true God and refuse to bow before the king's statue. Basic Truth: God loves me. Key Question: Who can trust the one, true God? Bottom Line: I can trust the one, true God.

WEEK 2

Daniel 6 God protects Daniel from the hungry lions. Basic Truth: God loves me. Key Question: Who is your protector? Bottom Line: God is my protector.

WEEK 3

Esther 2:2—8:17 God uses Queen Esther to save His people from destruction. *Basic Truth:* God made me.

Key Question: How does God work in the world? *Bottom Line:* God uses us for His big plans.

WEEK 4

Nehemiah 1—6 God's people come together to help Nehemiah repair the wall around their city. Basic Truth: God loves me.

Key Question: Who is good? *Bottom Line:* God is good. SIMPLE WAYS TO BRING THE LESSONS HOME...



MORNING TIME

As soon as you see your preschooler in the morning, tell him or her that you are going to start the day by stretching together. Stretch up to the sky and say together, "I can trust the one, true God!" Then touch your toes together and say, "I can trust the one, true God!" With every stretch, keep repeating that Bottom Line. Give your child a hug and tell him or her you are both ready to start the day now!



PLAY TIME

Add a toy tool set, blocks, or Duplos[®] to play time today. Encourage your child to build with you. Say, "God is so good. Nehemiah had a BIG job to do, but God sent a lot of people to help Nehemiah fix the city wall. God sends people to help us, too. Who are some of the people that help us?"



DRIVE TIME

While driving this month, remind children that Daniel and Esther both prayed to God. Say, "Daniel and Esther asked God to help them, and God did! Let's take time to pray to God right now." Lead your child in a prayer, and then encourage your child to pray.



BATH TIME

As you fill the tub, show your child how the faucet gives both cold and hot water. Ask them to name some other things that are cold (ice, snow, winter, popsicles, ice cream, etc.) and some other things that are hot (the sun, the stove, summer, fire, etc.) Point out that fire is very, very hot and people cannot touch it. It hurts and causes big boo-boos. Then, retell the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego and how they would only worship the one, true God, so the king threw them into the fiery furnace. They should have died from all that fire, but God protected them. We should never touch fire, but we can worship God and remember how He is mighty to save.



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child and pray. "Dear Father God, You are the one, true God! You protect us. You use us to do your work in the world, and You are good. We love you and thank You. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen."
