

WEEK 1

1 Kings 17:1-6

God sends ravens to feed Elijah.

Key Question: Who takes care of you?

Bottom Line: God takes care of me.

WEEK 2

1 Kings 17:7-16

God gives food to Elijah and a widow.

Key Question: Who is good?

Bottom Line: God is good.

WEEK 3

1 Kings 18:1-39

God answers Elijah’s prayers with fire from heaven.

Key Question: Who can you believe in?

Bottom Line: I can believe in the one, true God.

WEEK 4

2 Chronicles 34

King Josiah wants to live life God’s way.

Key Question: Whose way is best?

Bottom Line: God’s way is best.



SIMPLE WAYS TO BRING THE LESSONS HOME...



MORNING TIME

When you see your child first thing in the morning say, “Good morning, my wonderful daughter! Today, you will need so many things. You will need food. You will need water. You will need air to breathe. You will need clothes to wear and a house to live in. Who will take care of you and give you all these things? God will take care of you! He will give you everything you need!”



PLAY TIME

Pause play time to have a snack. Explain that God is so good. He is loving and kind, and He always does the right thing. He takes care of us, and He is the one who gives us good things like toys and food and a home and a family. Take the time to thank God for the snack and all the other good things God gives. Then, enjoy the snack together.



DRIVE TIME

When you get into your vehicle, tell your child where you are headed. Then, as soon as you start driving, say, “This is the way to [your destination.]” Anytime you make a turn, repeat that same phrase, saying, “This is the way to [your destination.]” When you arrive, say, “We took the right way to get to [your destination,] so we made it to [your destination!] Did you know that God tells us the right way? He does! He tells us the right way to LIVE! God’s way to live life is good. It’s the best way because God’s way is perfect.”



BATH TIME

At bath time, add several water-safe items that can be lined up on the edge of the tub. Encourage your child to choose eight of the items, place them on the edge of the tub, and count them aloud. Repeat several times. Each time your child counts the items, mention how Josiah was just eight years old when he became king, and he wanted to do things God’s way when he was just eight years old. Help your child say his own age. Tell him that he can love God’s way and do things God’s way, too.



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child and pray, “Dear Father God, We believe in You, the one, true God. There is no one like You. You are amazing and perfect and good. We believe in You, praise You, follow You, and love You. In Jesus’ name we pray. Amen.”
