[set up]

[living it out]

Spend time in prayer as a group. Use 1 Corinthians 1:1-9 and the insights that have been shared to shape your prayer time. Keep in mind how to (1) Praise God, (2) Thank God, (3) Confess to God, and (4) Make requests of God for both yourself, your group, and our church as you pray.
