Send & Serve Updates

Sending

- → Sent a small 6-person disaster relief team to Poland to help with disaster Ukrainian refugees
- → Commissioned the Scialabbas and became their Sending Church to Southeast, Asia through IMB
- → Commissioned Clay Myatt and established KXC as a Sending Church of CVC

- → Sent the Green family to work alongside our ministry partners in Mexico
- → Sent 3 Kentucky Disaster relief trips
- → Sent 15K+ to our 3 church plants in Western Ukraine

- → Sent over 50 people to Appalachia
- → Sent a team to Ghana to give a 360 assessment of our church partnership/created a Memorandum of Understanding
- → Commissioned the Hackets and became their Sending church to Uganda through IMB

Serving

- → Added 6 CVCers to the existing 11 to our MDT budget for Cross cultural missions work
- → Established a Mobile food pantry at our Brunswick Campus—The number of people they were able to serve grew from 55 in June to over 200 in December
- → Raised 15K+ for church planting, Bible training, and hospital expansion for our work in Ghana
- → Had 10 people complete a 15-week course on Perspectives in Global Missions
- → Raised 20K to send to Send Relief Ukraine in helping refugees fleeing to Poland
- → Established a second partner church in Appalachia

In addition to the money described above, we gave more than \$300K away in our budget to Mission related items.






