Accountability:

The Special Needs Coordinator works alongside of and is directly accountable to the Children's Minister.

Part-time position, 25 hours per week

Responsibilities:

- Motivate with a vision for developing community where special needs students and adults can experience truths about the Christian faith and develop a relationship with Jesus.
- Recruits, develops, trains, and leads a team of volunteers and ministry leaders to serve families and individuals with special needs
- Serves as a liaison with CVCKids, CVCYouth, and Community Life Ministries in creating inclusion and self-contained learning opportunities for Sunday School, worship, and other family activities
- Connects personally with volunteers, families and students within the Indispensable Ministry

- Communicates and promotes special needs ministry within the congregation and community
- Networks with community leaders in order to identify and provide appropriate opportunities for families and students.
- Assess the spiritual needs of families with special needs children and discover and implement strategic methods to better partner with parents and guardians.
 Collaborate with other ministries as needed.
- Develop experiences to foster relationships with our families/guardians.
- Help plan, develop, and manage our special needs component of our annual sports camp outreach.
- Help plan, develop, and manage our Night to Shine Special Needs Prom Outreach.
- Serve as a liaison with the Cuyahoga County Department of Developmental Disabilities, the area schools, and other community resources.
- Complete and submit all administrative tasks as directed in a timely manner. Track the number of special needs children and families, volunteers and training.
