### [start with prayer]

Why do you think the “laborers” are so few?

How does Jesus’ instruction to the “seventy-two” apply to us today?

What kind of results do you think they would have gotten without first following the Lord’s directions to “pray earnestly”?

### [living it out]

What is it that keeps many believers from praying passionately for “the Lord of the harvest” to send someone to touch a friend or family member?

What might happen if you prayed that it would be *you* that He sends?
