## CONNECT (10 MIN)

Think about a time when words had a significant impact on you, either positively or negatively. Do you remember what was said? Did the person speaking know their words had such an effect on you? Share your experience with the weight of words in your life.

#### EXPLORE (30 MIN)

#### Create Context (5 min):

#### Study & Discussion (25 min)

- Read the following passages: Proverbs 12:18, 15:4, 15:28, 16:24, 29:20. As we are asking the Lord to clean our hearts and change our speech, we can be purposeful in practicing godliness. What can you glean from these passages to put into action in order to bring life with your words?
- 3 Pastor Joe mentioned that the life-giving side of flattery is genuine encouragement. What does genuine encouragement look like? Use the 4 S's (Specific, Sincere, Strengths-based, Spirit-led) to bring genuine encouragement to someone in your group right now.
- In James 3:1-12, James uses very strong language to describe the immense power capable of such a small part of our body. Do your words reflect a belief that this is true? If what James is saying is true, why are we so flippant with the way we use our words? Read James 1:19-21. Why does James give this advice?



Read Matthew 12:33-37. We know that we are made right with God by grace through faith in Christ alone. Why does Jesus say here that we will be justified by our words?
