## SUNDAY SCHOOL AT HOME

Not able to attend church in person this week? We've put together a lesson plan so you can have Sunday School at home. The basic concepts are listed on the left, and some activities are printed below. We would also encourage you to use the Parent Cue for extension activities throughout the month. Remember that doing these specific activities isn't what matters, but leading your child spiritually does matter very much. These are simply tools that we are offering to help you step into or continue on in the role God has given you as a parent.

### 1. Prepare for the Bible Story

Instruct your child to crouch on the ground.

One by one, name some things that may or may not bring joy.

If your child hears something that brings her joy, encourage her to jump up from her crouching position.

You can list things like: swimming, broccoli, dinosaurs, etc.

End with the word "Christmas."

Explain that today's Bible story is all about Christmas.

### 2. Watch the Bible Story

Read pages 18-25 (The Sneaky Snake) in *The Beginner's Bible*.

Tell your child that the world was broken after the first sin.

Explain that God promised to send Someone Special to make things right between people and God.

That Special Someone was God's Son, Jesus.

Jesus came to earth as a baby.

We celebrate that at Christmas and all year long!

### 3. Worship with Song

Play "What Christmas Is About," and sing and dance along.

### 4. Practice the Memory Verse

Check out the Memory Verse for this month.

Teach your child the verse with the motions.

Connect the verse to the Bible story.

### 5. Review the Bible Story

Now, read pages 266-276 (An Angel Visits Mary) in *The Beginner's Bible*.

Say a prayer together to thank God for sending Jesus.
