LESSON OVERVIEW

Know what your child will learn at church, and synch it up at home.

NOVEMBER 2

Daniel eats God's way. (Daniel 1)

Basic Truth: **God made me.**

Key Question: **Whose way is best?**

Bottom Line: **God's way is best.**

NOVEMBER 9

God saves Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. (Daniel 3)

Basic Truth: **God loves me.**

Key Question: **Who can you trust?**

Bottom Line: **I can trust the one, true God.**

NOVEMBER 16

God protects Daniel from the lions. (Daniel 6)

Basic Truth: **God loves me.**

Key Question: **Who is your protector?**

Bottom Line: **God is my protector.**

NOVEMBER 23

God works through Esther to save His people. (Esther 2:2--8:17)

Basic Truth: **God made me.**

Key Question: **How does God work in the world?**

Bottom Line: **God uses us for His big plans.**

NOVEMBER 30

God helps Nehemiah rebuild the wall. (Nehemiah 1--6)

Basic Truth: **God loves me.**

Key Question: **Who is good?**

Bottom Line: **God is good.**

SIMPLE WAYS TO BRING THE LESSONS HOME



MORNING TIME

As soon as you see your child in the morning, tell him or her that you are going to start the day by stretching together. Stretch up to the sky and say together, “God loves me.” Then, touch your toes and say, “God loves me.” With every stretch, keep repeating that Basic Truth. Give your child a hug and tell him you are both ready to start the day now!



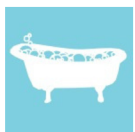
PLAY TIME

Add a toy tool set, blocks, or Duplos to play time today. Encourage your child to build with you. Say, “God is so good. Nehemiah had a BIG job to do, but God sent a lot of people to help Nehemiah fix the city wall. God sends people to help us, too. Who are some of the people who help us?”



DRIVE TIME

While driving this month, have children point out restaurants. Ask your child if he or she knows what kind of food is served at each place...hamburgers, ice cream, fries, tacos, etc. Ask your child to identify which foods are healthy and which foods should only be eaten once in a while. Tell our child that God made her body and knows what is best for it! God says foods like vegetables, fruits, and water are best. God also had special food that the Israelites were not supposed to eat. Daniel knew that and did things God’s way. He and his friends ate healthy foods that the Israelites were allowed to eat even when everyone else didn’t. God’s way is best!



BATH TIME

As you fill the tub, show your child how the faucet gives both cold and hot water. Ask them to name some other things that are cold (ice, snow, winter, popsicles, etc.) and some other things that are hot (the sun, the stove, summer, fire, etc.) Point out that fire is very, very hot and people cannot touch it. It hurts and causes big boo-boos. Then, retell the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego and how they would only worship the one, true God, so the king threw them into the fiery furnace. They should have died from all that fire, but God protected them. We should never touch fire, but we can worship God and remember how He is mighty to save.



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child and pray. “Father in heaven, You are the one, true, good God, and we can trust you. Please help us do things your way, and use us for your big plans. You are the protector of our lives. Thank you! In Jesus’ name we pray. Amen.”
