
Only 25% of believers look for ways to share the gospel and only 27% of them intentionally build friendships with unbelievers in order to do so

Transitions

Transitions

What are some felt needs you've heard people share in conversations?



Transition Statments

- "Can I show you a picture that really helped me understand the brokenness in the world—and in my life?"
- "That reminds me of something that has given me hope—can I draw it for you?"
- "I haven't been through that exact thing, but I've had similar struggles. Can I share something that really helped me?"



Group Training Reps

- 1. Start with a felt need. Pick one from the list, or one you've actually heard before.
- 2. Use a transition question to connect the felt need to the gospel.
- 3. Walk through the full 3 Circles.



Felt Need Examples

- Stress/Anxiety "I feel like I'm constantly overwhelmed."
- Fear/Uncertainty "I just don't know what the future holds."
- Loneliness "Even when I'm around people, I feel alone."
- Relationship Struggles "Our marriage/family has been really difficult lately."
- Health Concerns "I've been scared about my health."
- Guilt/Shame "There are things in my past I just can't move past."
- Financial Pressure "I can't seem to get ahead. It's exhausting."
- Hopelessness "Sometimes I wonder what the point of all this even is."
- Grief/Loss "I'm still hurting from losing someone close to me."
- The World's Brokenness "This world is just so messed up—it feels like everything is falling apart."



Week 2 Assignments

- Keep praying for your 3 people.
- Practice the 3 Circles 3 times this week—but this time, lead with a felt need and transition.
- If God gives you an opportunity with one of your 3, step into it with boldness.

Invitation to Respond (vv.30-31)

The times of ignorance God overlooked, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent"



How to Invite a Gospel Response

- 1. Identify Location: "Which circle best represents where you are right now?"
- 2. Invite Decision: "Is there anything keeping you from repenting and believing the gospel right now?"



Romans 10:9-10

because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.



Example Salvation Prayer

"God, I know I'm a sinner. Please forgive me and make me clean on the inside. I need You to heal the broken places in my life. I believe Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead. I'm repenting of my sins and believing in Jesus. Help me recover and pursue Your design for my life."

Invitation

Sample Red Light Response

"Thank you for listening to me. If you ever find yourself in a place of brokenness, please remember our conversation and that God has made a provision for you through His Son, Jesus."



Invitation

Sample Yellow Light Response

"You mentioned you need to think about this some more, and I think that's a great idea. I get together with some friends regularly to talk about life and God. We would love to have you join us."

Model - show someone how to share

Assist - practice together

Watch - encourage as they do it

Launch - send them to do it with others



Simple Discipleship

- 1. Affirm their decision and assure them of forgiveness.
- 2. Guide them into reading the Bible.
- 3. Pray with them regularly.
- 4. Encourage baptism and connection to church.
- 5. Walk with them model obedience and teach them how to share the gospel.
