SIMPLE WAYS TO BRING THE LESSONS HOME



MORNING TIME

When you go in your child's room in the morning each day this month say, "Good morning, [Child's Name]!" Hold your arms out wide and say, "Mommy/Daddy loves you THIS MUCH! And Jesus loves you even MORE!" Then, give your child a big hug. If you are looking for a great book to read this month, check out Hunter Beless' book called *Jesus Loves You More*.



PLAY TIME

Make some homemade heart cards for your friends and family. Talk about how Jesus loves everyone, so that means we should love everyone, too! Giving cards is a sweet way to say, "I love you!"



DRIVE TIME

As you drive along, every time you spot a person in the car next to you or crossing the street or even as you enter the grocery store, ask your child, "Does Jesus love that person?" The answer, of course, is YES! Jesus loves everyone!



BATH TIME

Add some toy friends to bath time this week. As your child counts, washes, and plays with the toy friends, talk about how God sent Jesus to be our savior and our friend. Jesus wants to be our friend forever.



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child and pray. "Father in heaven, we want to love everyone the way Jesus loves everyone. Please help [Child's Name] and me to love each and every person we meet, just like Jesus loves each and every person. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen."
