### Basic Truth

### Bottom Line

(Matthew 14:22-23)



# SIMPLE WAYS TO BRING THE LESSONS HOME

## MORNING TIME

When you go in your child's room in the morning each day this month say, "Good morning, [Child's Name]! Jesus is amazing! Let's praise Him before we do anything else." Then, sing a song together or say a prayer.



## PLAY TIME

Have a pretend picnic together. Give your child a blanket to place on the floor, some sort of basket to carry the food, and toy food items. Play together for a while. Then, review the Bible story of Jesus feeding the 5,000. Tell your child how there were many people who ended up having a picnic because Jesus did an amazing thing! He made lots and lots of food for everyone to eat out of only two fish and five loaves of bread. If you can, follow up your play session with a real picnic lunch together!



## DRIVE TIME

Play a game of "Can You Do That?" as you drive along. Take turns asking each other questions like, "Can you [touch the sun]?" When it's something impossible, say, "Not without Jesus. Only Jesus can do that!" When you get out of the car, say, "Jesus can do anything!"



## BATH TIME

Show your child how to take his fingers and make them "walk on water." Add some bubble bath and use your fingers to jump from one bubble mountain to the next bubble mountain. Talk about how walking on water is something only Jesus can do. He can do it because Jesus can do anything! Remind your child that Peter trusted Jesus as Lord and was also able to walk on the water. Ask "Do you think Peter would have been able to walk on the water without Jesus' help?" The answer is, "No!" Without trusting Jesus, Peter began to sink. Jesus is powerful and amazing! We should trust Him as the Leader of our lives, too!



## CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child and pray. "Father in heaven, You are amazing! We can see that in Your Son, Jesus, who shows us exactly what You are like. Help us never to lose our amazement of Jesus' power, might, and love. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen."
