SIMPLE WAYS TO BRING THE LESSONS HOME



MORNING TIME

When you go into your child's room in the morning, say, "You are fearfully and wonderfully made by God! I love you!" Then, give her a great, big hug.



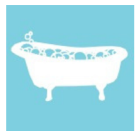
PLAY TIME

Play a game of "the floor is lava." Pretend that the floor is lava and that no one is allowed to touch it. You can place pillows and cushions all about the room so that you and your child are able to step from item to item without touching the floor. When you're finished playing, tell your child that in the game there was one rule...don't touch the floor. In the Garden of Eden there was one rule, too. God told Adam and Eve not to eat the fruit from the tree of good and evil. Adam and Eve disobeyed the rule and ate the fruit. Their disobedience brought sin into the world. We should always do what God says because God knows what's best for us.



DRIVE TIME

Since God made everything, let's turn Drive Time into a fun game of, "Look What God Made!" First, place your Creation Station hanging card on your rearview mirror. As you drive along, take turns naming things you see by saying, "God made the [name what you see.]" Then, see if you can name what day it was made. Look at your Creation Station hanging card to check your answers. Soon you'll be a creation pro!



BATH TIME

During bath time, give your child a toy fish with which he can play. Remind your child that God made all the fish and birds on day five of creation.



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child and pray, "Father in heaven, thank you for making so many wonderful things. You made bunnies, and flowers, and sunsets, and oceans, and grassy fields. You made lightning bugs, and hummingbirds, and mountains, and strawberries. You are the Good Thing Maker! Thank You! In Jesus' name we pray. Amen."
