The Shema

God's Word in your Heart, God's Word in your Home, God's Word on Display
from Deuteronomy 6:4-9

HEART – That our children would love God first

"You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart..." – Deuteronomy 6:5

As our children begin a new school year, pray that God would capture their hearts. Pray that their identity would be rooted in Christ rather than grades, achievement, sports, friendships, or scholarships.

HEART – That parents would model a faith that is real

Parents don't have to be perfect—they need to be intentional. Our children are watching how we respond to stress, disappointment, success, conflict, and failure.

HOME – That faith would be lived in the ordinary moments

"You shall teach them diligently to your children..." – Deuteronomy 6:7

Pray that faith would become part of everyday family life—in the car, around the dinner table, during homework, at bedtime, and in conversations about what our children experience at school.

HOME – That our homes would be places of grace and growth

Pray for parents to lead their families with intentionality rather than perfection. When parents fail, may they model humility, confession, forgiveness, and dependence on Jesus.

DISPLAY – That our families would show Jesus everywhere

"You shall bind them as a sign on your hand..." – Deuteronomy 6:8

What happens in our heart and is cultivated in our home becomes a display to the world.

Pray for our children as they enter classrooms, teams, friendships, and activities. Pray that they would display the character of Jesus through kindness, courage, integrity, compassion, and how they treat others.
